MORE THAN A FAMILY AFFAIR

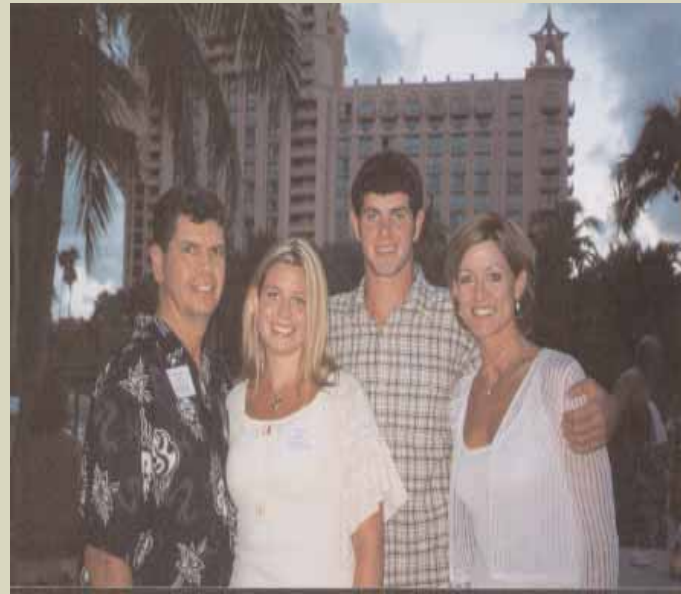
